I) Company agrees to provide Advisory, Consultancy, Supportive, facilitative and sourcing services in the areas as mentioned below:



- 3) Extending advisory assistance in designing & establishment of a state of the art communication lab, Industry Incubation cell(s), Simulation cum virtual lab at HMV premises.
- 4) Extending advisory assistance in designing teachers / Trainers Training Program(s) and Faculty Development Program(s), Quality Improvement Program(s).
- 5) Extending the needful advisory in designing and establishment of a functional 'AIM' department (if HMV prefers) with add on 'CARE' cell., to design and implement (help only) a flexible work force model (Teachers / Trainers only) which is an innovative concept.
- 6) Extending Advisory & sourcing services in HRM with a special focus on 'Skills Domain Faculty'.
- 7) Extending the needful advisory, consultancy, interactive, facilitative services in identifying the potential working partners (under 'AIM') from trade & industry sector.
- 8) Extending the needful advisory, consultancy, sourcing services for existing auditorium for strengthening the HMV.
- 9) Extending the needful Advisory services in Designing Industry Orientation program(s), Industry Tour(s), Industry Institute Interactive program(s) like work-shops, seminars which help in achieving inclusive growth rate for HMV, Hyderabad.
- 10) The company agrees to provide subject(s) related Orientation Program to the students during the course period.

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



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
- 11) The company agrees to brief the students at periodical intervals, through Guest lectures, focusing on the ever changing business environment.

- 13) The company agrees to extend guidance in planning for the Placement Assistance program(s).

ii) Both the parties mutually agree to the following:

- 14) This MOU is valid for a period of (03) three full financial years i.e.w.e.f. 01.04.2015 upto 31.03.2018; extendable for a mutually agreed period on mutually agreed terms, at least 30 days before the expiry of this MOU.
- 15) It is agreed that this MOU may be terminated by either party after giving 30 days notice period in writing, either in whole or in part. Further, either party may terminate the MOU, if the other party resorted to breach of this MOU & fails to cure such breach within ten days after receipt of the written notice of the said breach.
- 16) This MOU in no way restrict the company and HMV from participating in similar activities with other private or public agencies, organizations or individuals.
- 17) The company and HMV shall work hand in hand for achieving the desired results while implementing the terms of this MOU in true spirit.
- 18) HMV recognizes the shared responsibility it has with the company to abide by regulations in force.
- 19) Neither the company, nor HMV should discriminate against any individual on the basis of Age, caste, creed, color, religion, sex, nationality.
- 20) HMV shall designate one of it's faculty as co-coordinator for implementing this assignment in smooth way and the company shall extend the similar support for accomplishing mutual participation and satisfactory implementation of the programs.
- 21) This MOU supersedes all the earlier agreements (if any) prior to this agreement, either in oral or in written form. This MOU shall not be amended or altered except by written consent of both the parties.
