The College adopts the questionnaire proposed by the NAAC on Student Satisfactory Survey to obtain a formative feedback through online. This questionnaire consists of 20 questions and Suggestions which focuses on the teaching - learning, evaluation process and infrastructure of the institution. The activities of the institution are being analyzed to ensure a quality profile in relation to institutional vision. The results would enable the college to adopt a quality method of teaching - learning process as per the requirements of the industries.

The students are the most important stakeholders of the institute, their viewsor suggestions help the institute in formulating learning and teaching practices and are considered as prime data on which the quality of teaching and learning process is evaluated and enhanced.

All questions are mandatory and each student can give suggestions on the teaching - learning process and on the infrastructure of the institution. The questionnaire has been analyzed based on a 5-point scale. The results represent the opinion of students who participated in the survey. 
8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth:
